

SPRINKLER SYSTEM PERMITS

- A building permit is needed when:
 - interior sprinkler system is added
 - interior sprinkler system is replaced

If interior sprinkler system is done in connection with a larger project, ie new commercial building, additions, remodeling, include cost of system with building permit. No separate sprinkler system permit is required.

- Who can take out a permit:
 - property owner
 - contractor
- Permit application to include:
 - Owners name, mailing address and telephone number (if tenant applying for permit, letter is needed from property owner allowing project)
 - Contractor's name, mailing address, telephone number
 - Current use of property/building
 - Property address
 - Description of project
- Permit Fee:
 - Commercial
 - Inspection fee: 1% of project cost / minimum \$100.00
 - Electrical fee: \$75.00 (if applicable)
 - Plumbing fee: \$75.00 (if applicable)

Any work begun before a permit is secured, all fees are doubled.
