5 Batting Cages, 8 soft toss stations and 8 bullpens available for Warm-up

- We have 5 batting cages that will be at a first come, first serve basis. Please only one team per cage if teams are waiting to use them. Please limit your cage time to 30 minutes. Coaches must be present and players must wear helmets.
- There are 2 soft toss areas by each field (one down each baseline). The team that plays the next game on that field should be the one allowed to use them to warm up.
- We also have 2 bullpens per field (one down each baseline) to warm up pitchers.

Other Park Amenities

- Large Skate Park as you come into the park.
- 2 miles of walking trail system within the park.
- Large Playground next to a Shelter Area.
- 4 basketball hoops

Other Recreation Opportunities

- South Park Public Beach (Lifeguards and Diving Dock) Located in Downtown Waupaca at the end of South Main Street in South Park.
- Indoor Recreation Center (407 School Street) Basketball Courts, Dodgeball, Pool Tables, Computers, Games and Other fun. Please be our guest free of charge. This facility is supervised by Parks and Recreation Staff.
- Two Bowling Alleys
- Movie Theatre (Rosa Theatre) on Main Street.
- 3 area golf courses and 1 mini golf course.

Directions to Waupaca/Swan Park (address for GPS – 909 Brainerd Dr.)

From HWY 10 East (From Stevens Point)

- From Hwy 10 Exit Fulton Street (1st Exit by Hotel)
- Turn Left off 10 and Follow Fulton Street through (2) sets of lights.
- Turn Left on Hwy 49 North and Follow Swan Park signs to park.

From HWY 10 West (From Appleton, Oshkosh, etc.)

- Same as above except the Fulton Street Exit is the (4th) exit not the first exit.

From HWY 54 West (From Green Bay)

- Follow Hwy 54 until you get to the first set of lights. Go straight through the lights and veer right on School Street and follow past the Recreation Center and veer left on Badger Street. Follow until you get to another set of lights.
- Turn right on Main Street at the lights and go two blocks to another set of lights.
- Turn left on Fulton Street at the lights and follow to a few blocks to HWY 49 North.
- Turn right on Hwy 49 North and follow Swan Parks Signs to the park.

Directions when you get to HWY 49 North

Note: There are white signs with green lettering leading you to the park. The GPS address is 909 Brainerd Drive.

- North on HWY 49
- Turn Left on either North Street, Wisconsin Street, River Street
- Follow one of those until you hit Bailey Street and Turn right.
- Follow Bailey Street over a small bridge and veer to your right on Brainerd Drive.
- Follow Brainerd Drive until you reach the park on your right.
