CITY OF WAUPACA MERCURY POLLUTION MINIMIZATION PROGRAM

In an effort to minimize the health and environmental impacts of mercury in our community, an ongoing take-back program is being conducted at City Hall in Waupaca. The City of Waupaca will accept mercury thermometers, fluorescent lamps/bulbs, Compact Fluorescent Lights (CFL's) and mercury containing- thermostats at no charge. Drop-offs will be accepted during normal business hours at Waupaca City Hall Front Desk, 111 S Main St, Waupaca. Woolsey Plumbing & Heating, N2852 Cty Rd QQ, Waupaca is also accepting mercury containing thermostats during normal business hours.

-Severe Weather – severe weather warning notifications will be issued within seconds after being issued by the National Weather Service. Weather notifications are issued for the immediate threats of severe thunderstorm warnings, flash flood warnings and tornado warnings.

Other emergencies include:

- Drinking water contamination
- Utility outage
- Evacuation notice and route
- Missing person
- Fires or flood
- Bomb threat
- Hostage situation
- Chemical spill or gas leak
- Other emergency incidents where rapid and accurate notification is essential

REMOVAL OF ANIMAL WASTE

The owner or person having immediate control of a cat or dog shall promptly remove and dispose of in a sanitary manner, any feces left or deposited by the cat or dog upon public or private property, not owned or possessed by such person. It is unlawful for any person to permit a cat or dog to be on public or private property not owned or possessed by such person unless such person has in his immediate possession an appropriate means of removing animal feces. City of Waupaca Municipal Code Licenses and Permits Chapter 26.03 (1)



DRIVEWAY PERMITS

Did you know that if you want to add, replace, or fix your driveway within road right-of-way you would need a permit? A permit application can be found on the City of Waupaca website at:

or copies are available at Waupaca City Hall, 111 S. Main Street. This permit holds a *zero dollar fee*, but must be completed and approved before any driveway improvements within public right-of-way can occur. Please see municipal ordinance 8.11 or call Waupaca Public Works at 715-258-4420 for more information.

If you are planning landscaping work this spring, please contact the Water Department at **715-258-4423** to help locate your utility laterals. Proper location is key to prevent unnecessary damage to your laterals.
